How much can I win?

The prize will be 50% of the raffle ticket sale proceeds, up to a full year of tuition for one student. The more tickets sold, the higher the prize value. If all available tickets are sold, winnings will be equal to a full year of tuition.

**Tuition cost is equal to the net tuition cost, taking into consideration discounts or financial aid. It excludes Extended Day Tuition, any fees, incidental costs or supplemental program fees.*



When will the winner be announced? Do I need to be present to win?

The winner will be announced at the COVID-friendly 2021 Intercultural Soiree on April 17th, 2021. You do not need to be in attendance to win, though attendance is encouraged.

How much do the tickets cost and how many can I purchase?

The tickets are \$250 each. You can purchase as many of the 300 that will be sold that you wish to purchase.

Who can purchase tickets?

Any adult may purchase a ticket. This includes members of the Intercultural community, friends, family members, colleagues or neighbors.

How will the money be awarded?

The prize money will be awarded in the form of a SMART Tuition credit for the 2021-2022 school year.

Is the purchase of a raffle ticket considered a contribution to Intercultural?

No portion of the raffle ticket purchase is considered as a charitable contribution.

Will taxes need to be paid on the prize money?

Yes. Per the IRS, all prize money is considered as taxable income. Intercultural will issue the winner with the appropriate IRS forms and will withhold taxes in accordance with IRS regulations.

What are my chances of winning?

Up to 300 tickets will be sold. Each ticket purchased has at least a 1 in 300 chance of winning.

Can I purchase multiple tickets to improve my chances of winning?

Yes. Individuals may purchase multiple tickets.

What if the prize is not needed for tuition?

Prize winners who do not plan to use the prize toward tuition for their child will have the choice of either giving the credit to an enrolled family or donating the winning to Intercultural as a charitable contribution and receiving tax benefits allowed by law.

What if my child does not enroll in the 2021-2022 school year but another child may enroll at a later time?

Tuition credit less than or equal to the Primary Full Day Tuition Cost can be transferred to a family member or friend within three (3) years. If the tuition credit is not used by the 2023-2024 school year, it will be forfeited.

How can I purchase a ticket?

All ticket purchases must be made through the PayPal link. This will ensure that your information is captured and that 300 or fewer tickets are sold.
