Academic Year Tuition is based on the 40-week academic year and does not include our optional summer camps. Tuition is not based on student attendance nor is it reduced during holidays, breaks, or days the school is closed.

As a non-profit school, Intercultural Montessori strives to maintain reasonable tuition while retaining our talented, international teaching staff and continues to strengthen our programs. For this to happen, Intercultural looks to raise funds to cover the difference between tuition and the actual cost of educating a student. We ask families to participate in our Annual Fund and consider a donation of \$700 at minimum.
